Highlights: The three-time all-MAC Red honoree averaged 21 points and 13 rebounds per game this season for the Lancers. He has signed to play for Grand Valley State University next year.



Blake Cushingberry

School: Romeo
Year: Senior

Highlights: The four-year starter set the Bulldogs' career scoring record with more than 1,500 points. He earned MAC Red MVP honors this year after averaging 24.5 points and 11 rebounds per game. He will play at Oakland University.



Kyle Hunt

School: Ford
Year: Senior

Highlights: Two times the MVP of the MAC White, Hunt averaged 19 points, 10.5 rebounds, 3.0 steals and 3.0 assists per game this season for the Falcons, who won a piece of the division title.

Highlights: The junior led the Pilots to the regional title game this season after averaging 17.5 points and 4.5 rebounds per game. He was an all-Catholic selection and has verbally committed to Northwestern University.

Highlights: The three-year letter-winner broke the school record for points scored and earned all-MAC White honors for the third-straight year. Thompson averaged 14.5 points and 4.8 rebounds per game.

Bregé earned his third varsity letter this season for the Eagles, scoring 12.0 points per game in earning all-league honors. The junior earned his second-straight MAC Red first-team honor after averaging 20 points, 8.4 rebounds and two steals per game for the Lancers. The sophomore guard averaged 18.9 points, 6.9 rebounds and 4.9 assists to make his second-straight MAC Blue squad. The senior guard quarterbacked the Bulldogs to their third-straight MAC Red title; he averaged 15.5 points and 5.5 assists for Romeo. Third-year starter was among the MAC Red's best, averaging 19.9 points per game this year to earn all-division first-team honors.

The senior forward made his second-straight all-MAC White team after averaging 15.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game for the Patriots. Harville was an all-division pick in the Catholic League this year; he averaged 11.5 points per game for a district champion Pilot team. The junior guard averaged 15 points per game playing in the always-tough MAC Red Division this season. King, a three-year letterwinner for the Falcons, averaged 17 points and 7.0 rebounds for the co-MAC White champions; he was all-league.

Doran was the Big Reds' go-to-guy down on the blocks, averaging 10.0 points per game this season. The junior forward averaged a double-double this year, scoring 11 points and grabbing 11 rebounds per contest. Mack earned all-MAC Blue honors this season after averaging 14.0 points and shooting over 50 percent from long range. Senior guard was the Bulldogs' best defensive player, collecting a school-record 10 steals in a game earlier this season. The third-year letterwinner scored 12.1 points and 4.1 rebounds per game for the Crusaders; he was an all-White selection.
